Business dynamics

Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 30,196 Massachusetts establishments opened and 25,574 closed, for a net increase of 4,622. Employment expanded at 38,201 establishments and contracted at 58,335. Small businesses accounted for 29,501 openings and 24,458 closings.

Employment

Opening and expanding Massachusetts establishments added 254,295 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 458,441, for a net decrease of 204,146 jobs. Small businesses gained 191,276 jobs and lost 320,427, for a net decrease of 129,151 jobs.

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$2.3 billion in loans to Massachusetts businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. A total of 9,521 identified firms exported goods worth \$23.6 billion from Massachusetts in 2020. Of those exporters, 8,376—or 88.0 percent—were small.
