Business dynamics

Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 5,825 New Mexico establishments opened and 5,931 closed, for a net decrease of 106. Employment expanded at 10,338 establishments and contracted at 13,719. Small businesses accounted for 5,508 openings and 5,469 closings.

Employment

Opening and expanding New Mexico establishments added 64,297 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 109,415, for a net decrease of 45,118 jobs. Small businesses gained 45,355 jobs and lost 78,225, for a net decrease of 32,870 jobs.

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$433.2 million in loans to New Mexico businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less.
