Employer and employment dynamics

Establishments

Between March 2022 and March 2023, 2,496 Alaska establishments opened and 2,065 closed, for a net increase of 431. Employment expanded at 5,282 establishments and contracted at 4,623. Small businesses accounted for 2,390 establishment openings and 1,961 closings.

Employment

Opening and expanding Alaska establishments added 27,474 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 20,716, for a net increase of 6,758 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 4,442 jobs, or 65.7 percent of that total. Thousands of establishments

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2022, reporting banks issued \$192.1 million in loans to Alaska businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less.
