#### Employer and employment dynamics

#### **Establishments**

Between March 2023 and March 2024, 10,446 Arkansas establishments opened and 9,538 closed, for a net increase of 908. Employment expanded at 19,638 establishments and contracted at 17,413. Small businesses accounted for 9,630 openings and for 8,949 closings.

#### Employment

Opening and expanding Arkansas establishments added 118,458 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 102,091, for a net increase of 16,367 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 14,245 jobs, or 87.0 percent of that total.

#### Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2023, reporting banks issued \$1.1 billion in loans to Arkansas businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$2.5 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$848.9 million.
