




Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2023, reporting banks issued \$3.3 million in loans to territory businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$13.1 million. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$4.0 million.
